

EJ Origins Tour – Lucky Draw Testimonial Competition

Terms & Conditions

Last updated: 18 February 2026

1. Promoter

1. The promoter of this competition (“Competition”) is EJ Australia Pty Ltd (ABN 48 010 591 956), of Lot 2, 354 South Pine Road, Brendale 4500 Queensland (“EJ” or “the Promoter”). Contact: 07 3216 5000 / EJOriginsTour@ejco.com.
2. Information on how to enter and prizes form part of these terms and conditions (“Terms”). By participating, entrants (“Entrants”) agree to be bound by these Terms.

2. Eligibility

1. Entry is open to all clients of EJ Australia and engineers and architects who enter during the Competition Period as set out in clause 4 below and are aged 18 years or over.
2. Directors, management, employees of EJ, its related entities, and their immediate family members, as well as agencies associated with this Competition, are not eligible to enter.
3. Entry is only open to residents of Australia in all Australian States and Territories.

3. Competition Overview

1. To enter, eligible participants must, during the Competition Period:
 - Record a short video testimonial on their mobile phone or another electronic device, describing their positive experience with EJ (“Entry”).
 - Upload their Entry to the Promoter’s website located at www.ejoriginstour.au, along with their name, email address, and contact details. It is the responsibility of the entrant (“Entrant”) to ensure they have ongoing access to the email account used to submit their Entry.
 - The Entrant must ensure the content of their video testimonial is an accurate and not-misleading description of their experience.
2. Only Entries that comply with these Terms will be accepted and Entrants are responsible for the content of their Entry.
3. Each Entrant may submit only one Entry.
4. By entering, Entrants agree to the use of their video, name, and likeness by EJ for marketing and promotional purposes, as described below in clauses 8 and 10(2).
5. The cost of accessing the website to enter the Competition will be dependent upon the Entrant’s individual internet service provider.
6. Incomplete Entries will be deemed invalid.
7. If an Entry is invalid, the Promoter reserves the right to discard that Entrant’s Entry and proceed as if that Entrant had not entered the Competition.
8. By submitting a video testimonial in accordance with clause 3(1) above, Entrants are deemed to have accepted these Terms.

4. Competition Period

1. Entries open at 9:00am (AEST) on 23 February 2026 and close at 5:00pm (AEST) on 16 October 2026 (“Competition Period”). Entries received after the closing date will not be eligible. Entries from the ACT will only be accepted from 26 February 2026.
2. Entries are deemed to have been received at the time of receipt into the Promoter’s database and not at the time of transmission by the Entrant.

5. Stage 1 - Judging

1. The winner of the Competition (“Winner”) will be determined in two stages.
2. In Stage 1, all valid Entries will be individually assessed by a panel of three judges from the EJ Asia Pacific Leadership Group and True Creative (“Judges”). The Entries will be judged based on, but not limited to, the following criteria:
 - a) (Originality and creativity): the presentation, communication style, content and message conveyed;
 - b) (Engagement and impact): the ability of the Entry to effectively represent EJ and its Australian brand to both viewers and the Promoter’s USA leadership groups; and
 - c) (Relevance and alignment): the extent to which the Entry positively and accurately reflects the Promoter’s Australian brand and values, as well as the Entrant’s genuine experience.
3. Judging will take place at EJ Brendale Workshop, Lot 2, 354 South Pine Road, Brendale 4500 Queensland over the competition period and will conclude with the close on 16 October 2026 5:00pm AEST.
4. Only Entries selected by the Judges (“Shortlisted Entries”) will proceed to Stage 2. The number of Shortlisted Entries will be determined at the Judges’ discretion.
5. The Judges’ Stage 1 decisions are final and binding and no correspondence will be entered into.

5A. Stage 2 - The Draw

1. Stage 2 consists of a random, lucky draw (“Draw”) from the Shortlisted Entries and will take place at EJ Brendale Workshop, Lot 2, 354 South Pine Road, Brendale 4500 Queensland on 23 October 2026 11:00am AEST (“Prize Draw Date”).
2. The Draw will be live-streamed and recorded for public viewing.
3. All valid Entries will be placed into an EJ-branded container (e.g. a hard hat), and a celebrity or relevant public figure will draw one Winner at random.
4. The Draw recording will be uploaded to www.ejoriginstour.au after the event.
5. The Draw will be conducted in accordance with the requirements of the lottery and trade promotion laws applicable in the State of Queensland (or the State where the Draw is held).
6. The first valid Entry drawn will be the Winner of the Competition. Winning is not contingent on being present at the Draw.
7. The Draw will be scrutinised by an independent person, unless an exemption is granted by a regulatory authority.

6. Prize

1. The prize consists of a VIP “EJ Origins Tour”, organised and paid for by EJ Australia, valued between AUD \$30,000 to \$40,000, that includes:

- a) A business class airfare for two people from Australia to Northern Michigan, USA.
- b) 5 nights’ accommodation for two people in Charlevoix, USA; at or of a similar standard to the Edgewater Inn or Weathervane Terrace Inn, and
- c) Transfers from Traverse City airport to the Charlevoix accommodation, as well as transfers between the accommodation and the EJ Foundry, (“Prize”).

2. The Prize is not transferable or exchangeable and cannot be redeemed for cash.

3. The Promoter reserves the right to substitute the Prize with another of equal or greater value if required due to circumstances beyond its control, including but not limited to changed travel restrictions or government regulations in the Prize destination.

4. The Prize must be redeemed within 12 months of the Prize Draw Date.

5. The Prize does not include meals, drinks, insurance, or passport/visa issuance costs, which are the responsibility of the Winner. All expenses other than those expressly referred to in clause 6(1) will be at the Winner’s and their companion’s cost. The Winner has the sole responsibility of ensuring they meet all travel requirements, including but not limited to obtaining valid travel documentation and complying with any health, safety or security advisories issued by relevant authorities. The Winner should seek independent travel advice prior to redeeming the Prize.

6. All taxes (excluding goods and services tax), which may be payable as a consequence of receiving the Prize, are the sole responsibility of the Winner.

6A. Prize delivery

1. The Prize will be provided or presented to the Winner within 28 days after the Prize Draw Date.

2. The Winner will be notified about how the Prize will be delivered within 7 days of the Prize Draw Date.

7. Winner Notification and Verification

1. The Winner will be notified in writing by email and/or SMS to the email address or phone number submitted at the time of Entry within 5 business days of the Prize Draw Date.

2. The Winner’s first name initial, surname and postcode will also be published on www.ejoriginstour.au and EJ’s social media channels for a minimum of 28 days on and from the Prize Draw Date.

3. The Promoter may request proof of identity and eligibility before awarding the prize.

4. If the Winner cannot be contacted or does not claim the prize within 14 days, the Promoter reserves the right to conduct a re-draw in accordance with clause 7A below.

7A. Unclaimed prize

1. The Promoter will make reasonable efforts to identify and locate the Winner.
2. If the Prize remains unclaimed within three months after the Prize Draw Date, an unclaimed Prize draw will be held at Lot 2, 354 South Pine Road, Brendale 4500 Queensland at 22 January 2027 11:00am AEST, subject to the approval of any necessary regulatory authority (“Unclaimed Prize Draw”).
3. The Winner of the Unclaimed Prize Draw will be notified in the same manner as set out in clause 7(1) and all other Terms will apply as though it were the original Draw.
4. The Promoter assumes no responsibility for any failure to receive an Entry or for inaccurate information or for any loss, damage or injury as a result of technical or telecommunications problems. If such problems arise, the Promoter may (where necessary with the approval of the relevant regulatory authority) modify, cancel, terminate or suspend the Competition.

8. Use of Content (intellectual property and moral rights)

1. By entering this Competition and submitting a video testimonial, Entrants grant EJ globally a non-exclusive, royalty-free, perpetual licence to use, reproduce, edit, and publish their testimonial (in whole or part) for promotional and marketing purposes in any media, including online and social media channels.
2. EJ may edit selected videos to a short duration (30–45 seconds) for publication.
3. Entrants acknowledge and agree that their testimonial and likeness may be viewed publicly on eoriginstour.au and associated EJ channels.
4. No payment or compensation will be provided for the use of any video content submitted.
5. By entering this Competition, Entrants consent to the Promoter dealing with their Entry content in any way that may otherwise infringe the Entrants’ moral rights and agree not to assert their moral rights in respect of their Entry against the Promoter or its assigns, licensees or successors.
6. Entrants warrant that their Entry is not in breach of any third-party intellectual property rights.

9. Privacy

1. Personal information collected from Entrants, including the Entrants’ name, email address and contact details will be collected and used solely for the purpose of administering this Competition and for promotional and marketing purposes and in accordance with EJ’s Privacy Policy (available at www.ejco.com/ap/en/privacy-policy). This may require disclosure to third parties, including local regulatory authorities and the Promoter’s agents or third-party service providers, for the purpose of conducting the Competition, or for promotional and marketing purposes (including for direct marketing)(“Purpose”).
2. By entering this Competition, Entrants consent to their personal information being collected, stored, and used for the Purpose, and that the Promoter may use this information for that purpose (and disclose it to other organisations or persons including overseas service providers located in the USA and Europe that may use it, in any media for the Purpose).

3. Entrants may request access to, or correction of, their personal information by contacting EJ at EJOriginstour@ejco.com. EJ's Privacy Policy also contains information about how individuals may access or correct personal information or make a privacy-related complaint.

10. Publicity and Filming

1. The VIP Tour will be filmed and highlights will be published on eoriginstour.au and EJ's social media platforms.
2. In addition to clause 8 above, by accepting the prize, the Winner agrees to participate in publicity and promotional activities for an unlimited period of time without further compensation for the purpose of promoting any products manufactured, distributed or supplied (or both) by the Promoter.

11. General Conditions

1. The Promoter accepts no responsibility for late, lost or misdirected Entries or other communications.
2. The Promoter reserves the right to disqualify any Entry that is incomplete, indecipherable, or violates these Terms.
3. If the Competition is interfered with or cannot be conducted as planned due to technical issues, fraud, or any other reason beyond EJ's control, EJ reserves the right to cancel, suspend, or modify the Competition, subject to any directions from a regulatory authority.
4. Nothing in these Terms in any way limits an Entrant's rights under the Australian Consumer Law and other similar legislation which cannot be excluded, restricted, or modified by the Promoter.
5. Whilst an element of skill is involved in Stage 1 to shortlist Entrants (see clause 5 above), the ultimate Winner is determined by a random Draw in Stage 2. Therefore, this Competition is classified as a game of chance.
6. All Entries become and remain the property of the Promoter upon submission and will not be returned to Entrants unless otherwise provided for in these Terms.
7. The Promoter reserves the right to request verification of any social media profiles of Entrants, and of the age, identity and any other information relevant to entry into or participation in the Competition. Verification is at the discretion of the Promoter. Failure by the Promoter to enforce any of its rights does not constitute a waiver of those rights.
8. Despite clause 11(4) above, to the extent that it is permitted to do so, the Promoter excludes and is not responsible or liable for any loss, damage, injury or death (even if caused by negligence) suffered in connection with this Competition or the Prize, except for any liability that cannot be excluded by law. The Winner must sign all legal documentation required by us as a condition of accepting the Prize.
9. All Entrants and the Winner indemnifies the Promoter, its related entities and agents, from any loss, damage or expense arising from a breach by any Entrant or the Winner of these Terms.
10. If anything contained in these Terms is held to be invalid or unenforceable, that term will be severed from these Terms and the remaining terms will continue in full force.

12. Governing Law

This Competition, these Terms and any claim or dispute between the Promoter and an Entrant are governed by the laws of the State of Queensland, Australia, and all Entrants submit to the exclusive jurisdiction of the courts of Queensland.

12A. Dispute resolution

In the event of a dispute concerning the conduct of the Competition or claiming of the Prize, Entrants must contact the Promoter to attempt to resolve the dispute in good faith. If the matter cannot be resolved, either party may refer the matter to mediation administered by an agreed-upon alternative dispute resolution organisation. The costs of mediation will be shared equally between the parties.

13. Permits

As required under State and Territory legislation, EJ will obtain the necessary trade promotion lottery permit(s) prior to conducting the draw.
